### **VI. Participation and Outcome:**

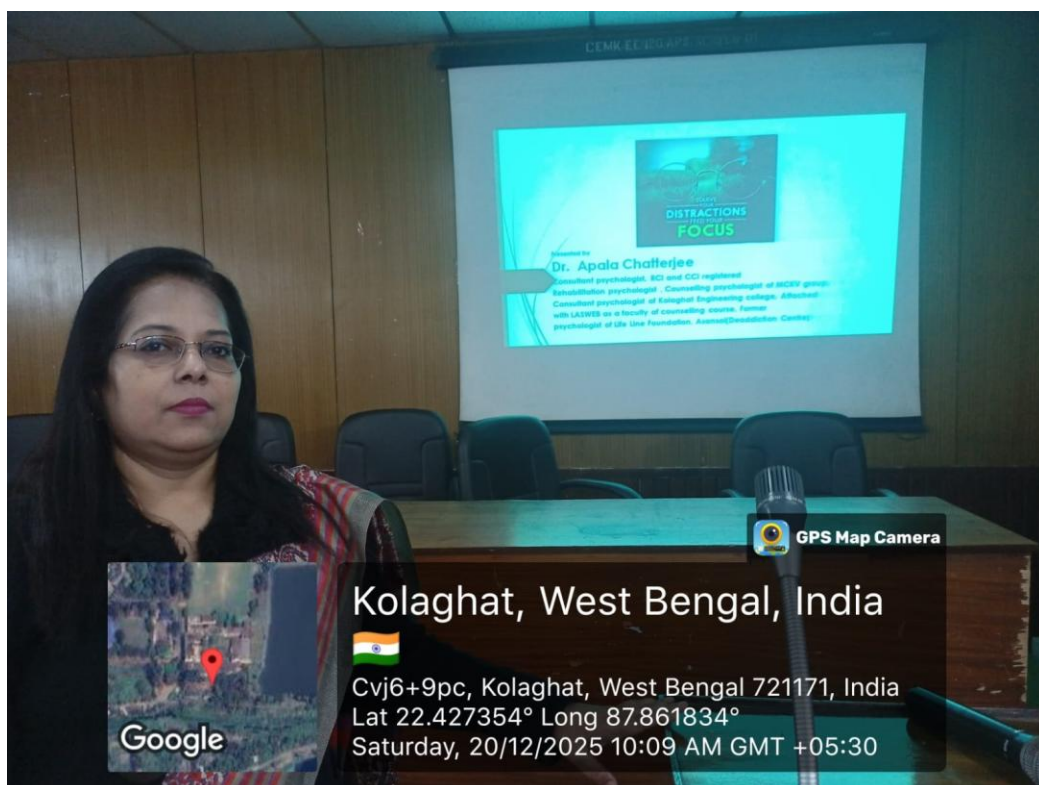
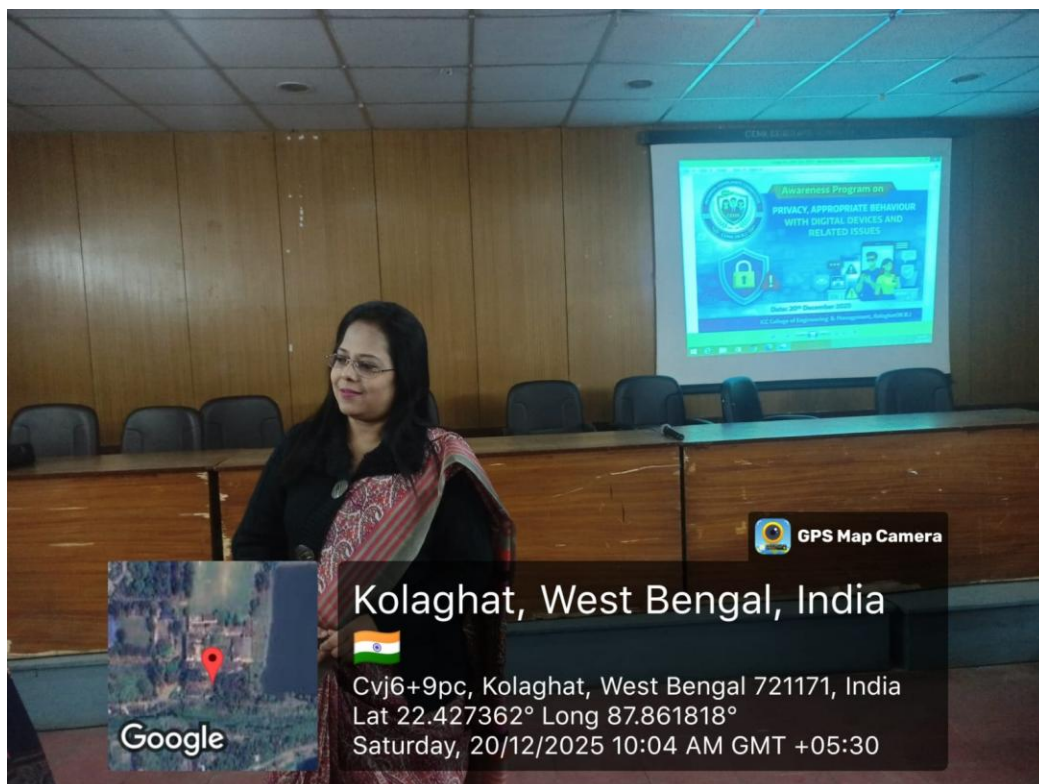
